1 Castle Hill

Besides the monuments you get breathtaking panorama from of the Danube with the Chain Bridge and the opposite Pest side. The spectacular Royal Palace Budapest sits high atop Castle Hill, where it towers almost 150 feet above the city and overlooks the Danube and the Pest side of the river.



3 Spoon Restaurant

The location of the restaurant, cafe and lounge Spoon is unique in Budapest. In the heart of Budapest the Danube directly at chain bridge is the 2 floor boat with restaurant Spoon on it. Docked on the Pest side next to chain bridge you have a brilliant view on all attractions of the Buda side like Castle district or Gellert hill.



2 The Fisherman's Bastion

Fisherman's Bastion in Budapest is well-known for its views of the city. The paths and steps lead to wonderfully scenic lookouts over Budapest. Gazing down from Fisherman's Bastion, Budapest can be viewed almost in its entirety in a stunning panorama. The white-stoned construction was built between 1895 and 1902. The structure has seven towers that symbolize the seven Magyar tribes that came to Hungary in 896.



4 Vaci street and Vörösmarty Square

The street known as Vaci was formed in the 18th century, though most of the lovely architecture that visitors will find as they make their way down this popular street is from the 19th and early 20th centuries. The avenue has long been a place where the rich and famous of Budapest enjoyed spending their money though



5 New York Palace, Cafe

You find this beautiful café in the ground floor of a luxury New York Palace on the Grand Boulevard of Budapest's Erzsébet. Built by an insurance company as a company hall New York Café, was a long time centre for Hungarian literature and poetry, almost from it is opening on October 23rd 1894



6 Gellert Thermal Bath

We find records about the "miraculous" springs spurting up on the territory of the Bath from as early a date as the 15th century. These springs were later favoured by the Turks as well, as they were larger and hotter than the Buda baths of the period. In the 17th century, the site was named Sárosfürdő (Mud bath) because of the fine spring silt that was pushed up together with the spring water and settled at the bottom of the pools.



7 Gellért Hill, Liberation Monument

Gellert Hill is a major attraction in Budapest, the capital city of Hungary, and a must-see on your Hungarian holiday. Gellert Hill is a 230 meters hill named Gellert who was a Roman Catholic bishop killed by pagan Hungarians in 1046 by being thrown down the hill. From visiting the citadel to the nearby Liberation Monument to the Gellert Hill Cave and the Gellert Baths, there are many attractions at Gellert Hill and beautiful panoramic views of the whole city.



8 Pomo D'Oro Restaurant

You can eat the best pumpkin and parmesan pasta dish here which will be better than any pasta dish you have ever tasted. The service impeccable, attentive without being intrusive.
